## WATER USER AGREEMENT

I, \_\_\_\_\_\_hereby make application to Beaverfork Public Water Authority for water service at the following location:

This agreement is for users who will be using water and does not include "dry taps". Applicant and Property Owner, both agree to the following:

- 1. To install and maintain, at my expense, the necessary service line to be connected to the water system at the property line of the property address above, which is owned or occupied by me and install & maintain all backflow prevention devices required by Health Department & Beaverfork PWA rules & regulations. The undersigned agrees to indemnify BPWA from and against all expenses, losses & liabilities that BPWA may incur as a result of the failure by the undersigned to maintain service lines & backflow prevention devices.
- 2. To begin using water immediately after being notified that service is available, or to pay the minimum water bill each month until connection is made to the system. Failure to pay the minimum monthly bill until connection is made by me, will result in a "disconnect" at the end of three months or any month thereafter in which the minimum bill is not paid. In case a "disconnect" is declared by Beaverfork PWA, all deposits and payments made will be forfeited. A new connection fee will be charged when service is again requested.
- 3. To use the water in accordance with rules and regulations as established by Beaverfork PWA and to promptly pay for the water at the applicable schedule of rates.
- 4. If applicable, to pay with this agreement, a connection fee of \*\$\_\_\_\_\_. The meter connection fee must be paid in full before the meter is installed.
- 5. The undersigned Property owner hereby grants to Beaverfork PWA an easement across the Property Owner's land for the installation, operation & maintenance of water lines over, under or across the Property Owner's land.
- 6. If meter is tampered with, customer agrees to pay tampering fee of \$500.00. This rule applies if the meter is tampered with in any way or if a meter is shut off due to non-payment. Meter will be locked on first offense, if tampered with after first offense customer will be prosecuted to fullest extent of the law. If criminal charges are applied the meter will be pulled & customer will not be allowed to have service with Beaverfork Public Water again.
- 7. Attached hereto as Exhibit A are the additional policies and procedures that the Applicant and the Property Owner, as evidence by their signature hereto, agree to abide by.
- 8. As evidenced by our signatures below, but the Applicant and the Property Owner hereby agree to be jointly and severally liable and responsible for the payment of all water invoices submitted by BPWA in connection with water services rendered.
